1	Host event sponsored by or on behalf of a community organization relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	On February 13, 2025, KBDI-TV (PBS12) hosted the Northglenn Senior Group for a tour of the Station/control room conducted by our Studio Manager, during which he shared information about the various career opportunities in television broadcasting. Following the tour, the group was invited to observe a studio shoot of the show <i>Colorado Inside Out</i> . After the shoot, our Host and four community leaders involved in the production of the show interacted with the group for a question-and-answer session about broadcast television production.
2	Host event sponsored by or on behalf of an educational institution relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	On May 21, 2025, KBDI-TV (PBS12) hosted the Black Youth Excellence high school club from DSST Green Valley Ranch for a tour of our Station by our Studio Manager. The students received a brief introduction to television broadcasting, during which career opportunities in television broadcasting were discussed, and observed our new studio set up and how the cameras work.
3	Host event sponsored by or on behalf of an educational institution relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	On June 26, 2025, our Station hosted 12 students from the Arts Hub Kids Film Festival (winners) to tour the studio and sit in on a taping of our weekly show, Colorado Inside Out, during which career opportunities in television broadcasting were discussed with our show Host/Contract employee and our Studio Manager.

4	Host event sponsored by or on behalf of an educational institution relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	September 21–25, 2025, PBS12 hosted the National Press Photographers Association (NPPA) for a week-long training workshop. Fifty photojournalists from across the country participated, and one of PBS12's own photojournalists helped lead the program by overseeing the event and teaching one of the sessions. This outreach supported professional development within the industry and fostered broader engagement with emerging and established media professionals.
5	Host event sponsored by or on behalf of an educational institution relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	On November 30, 2025, PBS12 hosted a group of high school students from DMLK Fayola Man Career Academy. This group of young men were given a tour of our studios, control room, and editing bays by our Studio Manager and our Production Technical Specialist, during which they shared information about the various career opportunities in television broadcasting. They also explained how technology has changed the Station's production efforts.
